What is this programme?

The Global Best Practice Programme is Expo 2020 Dubai's platform to showcase projects that have provided tangible solutions to the world's biggest challenges.

It will highlight simple but effective initiatives, which localise the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and can be adapted, replicated, and scaled to achieve an enhanced global impact.

Register you email address and create an account for our online submissions portal.

You will then receive an email asking you to activate your account with your new password. The activation link is valid for 24 hours only. If you do not activate your account within this time, you will need to go to the forgotten password login page & create a new one, along with entering the Captcha details. If you need to reset your password at a later stage, you will need to repeat this step.



Enter your login details here & begin your application.



You can save your submission as a draft before submitting.



Once you have finished your submission, click on the submit tab at the bottom of the page. The status will change from 'Draft' to 'Submitted'. You can add multiple submissions if you have several eligible projects.
